**Description**

- In support of DFW Airport's 19th Street cargo project, it is necessary for American Airlines to relocate several functions from its West Warehouse.
- This project consists of the relocation of all functions currently housed within the West Warehouse Facility on 19th Street. The West Warehouse Facility is scheduled for demolition as part of the 19th Street project.
- In June 2023, the DFW Board approved a Reimbursement Agreement with American Airlines for the relocation of the West Warehouse in an amount not to exceed \$20,763,428.44.
- This action is to amend Reimbursement Addendum #29 to the full \$23,000,000 MII approved amount for the West Warehouse.

**Justification**

- This increase is necessary to support DFW Airport's strategic cargo initiatives and increased construction costs.
